In attendance: Chair Tammy Mahoney, School Board Subcommittee members Jamie Fitzpatrick and Dawn Dutton, Superintendent Tom Ambrose, Director of Teaching and Learning Patty Haynes, Director of Academic Intervention, Assessment, and Accountability Christine Desrochers, Director of Guidance Heidi Leavitt, K-6 Math Coordinator Donna Donnell, HS Assistant Principal Steve Krzyzanowski, MS Principal Matt Malila, Memorial Principal Ryan McCloskey, Bakie Principal Troy Kennett, HS Math teachers Jillian Spero and Corey Fielding, MS Math teachers Scott Kramer and Carol Marino. Called to order by Chair Mahoney at 4:15 pm. Minutes of the 4/13/22 meeting were reviewed and approved by a unanimous vote.

Dr. Haynes presented the results of the MS/HS math curriculum search, and the recommendation is to adopt Reveal for grades 6-12. The high school teachers who attended had the opportunity to pilot the program and spoke highly in favor of the ease of student engagement and adoption, and the variety of opportunities for independent practice and differentiation. The middle school teachers also highlighted the interactivity and customization capabilities. The committee members thanked them for their efforts and expressed their support. Ms. Dutton also commented that she appreciates their enthusiasm for the program. Mr. Fitzpatrick noted that the program will support consistency between grade transitions and the ability for differentiation in practice exercises. Ms. Mahoney looks forward to implementing an integrated math program. Dr. Haynes noted that due to supply challenges, and for PD planning purposes, they hope to order the materials as soon as possible. Mr. Fitzpatrick moved to recommend the program to the board at the May 18 meeting, seconded by Ms. Dutton; all in favor.

Dr. Haynes also presented an example of a grade level curriculum overview document that staff will be developing for use in grades K-8, to help inform parents about the programs, skills, and concepts for each grade level in a broad, coherent overview. Mr. Fitzpatrick moved to adopt the grade level overview, seconded by Ms. Dutton; all in favor.
