A Message from Administration:

Dear Sanborn Students and Families,

We hope you all had a wonderful summer! We could not be more excited to welcome students back to our building for the 2023-2024 school year. School will start for students **in grade 9 only** on Monday, August 28th. Students in grades 10-12 will start on Tuesday, August 29th. School starts at 7:20AM. Please review the important information below:

Student Schedules: Student schedules are now available in ALMA. In order to access your schedule click on the "classes" tab. Please know school counselors will not be back in the office to respond to questions until at least August 18th. If your student would like to request a schedule change, please have them complete the google form which can also be found on the high school website. School counselors will only work from the google form to make schedule changes, they will not be able to respond to individual emails. If they have questions for your student, they will reach out to him/her via their school email. Some of you may see classes in your schedule that you are not sure what they mean. For instance: ELO (Extended Learning Opportunity) you may have this in your schedule if you requested either an ELO or an Internship. You may also have this in your schedule if you requested a class that we could not fit into your schedule. If you have ELO, you will meet with Mrs. Alley in the auditorium on the first day of school (during your assigned ELO period) and she will let you know what you will need to be doing that period. If you have ED Lab in your schedule, this is the new name for PASS class and it will be scheduled with a case manager. It may not be with a case manager that you are familiar with but you will meet with someone to talk about the new plans for PASS class. If you have an Online lab in your schedule, you may already be enrolled in online classes or you may need to meet with your counselor to set up an online class because you were not able to fit your requested class in your schedule.

If you are an incoming freshman from Fremont, please check your email for instructions on how to activate your ALMA account in order to see your schedule/classes.

Bell Schedule: The bell schedule for the 2023-2024 school year has a few slight adjustments from last year. Please <u>CLICK HERE</u> to access the bell schedule.

Back to School Forms: Students may not start school until all back to school forms have been completed. These must be done in the "ALMA Start" module. Information on how to access this online portal can be found HERE and is included in this email/packet. Back to school forms must be completed by Thursday, August31st. After August 31st, Google accounts will be suspended until the forms are complete.



Athletic Update:


Athletics Are On!


